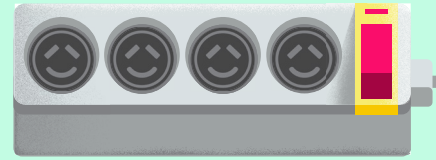


New house electrical equipment safe setup checklist



Moving into a new place? Make sure you're being safe with your electrical appliances. Here are some tips to get you started – but if you're unsure, always consult an electrician!

Pre-move check:

Are all power outlets in good condition and working properly? Visually check for loose attachment to wall, water damage or physical defects – don't touch if damage is apparent. Get an electrician in for any repair needed.

Has the wiring and fuse box been checked by an electrician to ensure safety and no blown fuses?

Have you identified each room's available power outlets and mapped your current electrical appliance plug in needs accordingly?

Are light fittings in good working order? Check for loose fittings, downlights clear from any obstruction like insulation or enclosure material.

Moved in:

Is the power switched on in the home at the box?

Have you checked your electrical equipment for damage or defects during the move?

Have you safely plugged in appliances to each room without overloading the outlet?

If you are using multiplugs, are you observing the maximum wattage load and staying under this?

Do all lights have the appropriate bulbs installed? Consider changing all bulbs for new eco bulbs at once.

Any outdoor electrical equipment like lighting or garden features? Are these safely wired in and weatherproof?
